The Bloomington Animal Shelter is seeking motivated and compassionate individuals to provide enrichment and basic behavior modification through gentle methods primarily of positive reinforcement, counter conditioning, classical conditioning, etc. The individuals will often work with dogs that are experiencing behavioral issues within the shelter environment. These dogs can have issues varying from kennel stress, dog to dog reactivity, fearfulness, little or no training, etc. The intern must have working knowledge of general canine body language, dog to dog body language and have safe animal handling skills. The individuals must be able to work independently as well with staff members. Completion of a shelter orientation is required before internship begins.
