Are you interested in working with wild birds and spending time outdoors? The Rosvall Lab in the Biology Department is seeking paid entry-level field technicians for 2023 spring and/or summer. We study wild birds that breed in bird houses - which our field technicians help monitor and maintain.

- Starting pay: \$13-15/hour

- Learn hands-on techniques in bird biology and field research
