JOB RESPONSIBILITIES

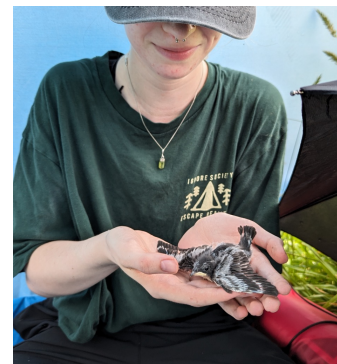
- Maintain and repair bird houses
